LIQUIBOND 50 is an alumina and mullite based, chemically bonded refractory having excellent thermal shock resistance, high refractoriness and strength at high temperatures.

LIQUIBOND 50 is recommended for aluminum furnace applications such as sills and troughs. It also may be used for burner blocks and other special shapes. This material may be used anywhere fast, reliable set times, and good strengths are needed.
